Admission Process and Guidelines:

The Degrees, Diplomas and Certificate programmes of Krishna Vishwa Vidyapeeth (Deemed to be University), Karad shall have the same status as of those given by any Statutory University duly recognised by the University Grants Commission (UGC).

Admissions to all programmes shall be made as per inter – se merit as the qualifying examination and or rest, as prescribed from time to time.

The candidates whose names are included in the Merit list, prepared on the basis of marks obtained by them in Physics, Chemistry and Biology in the qualifying examination, taken together and at the Krishna All India Entrance Test (KAIET) conducted by the University and those candidates who have secured at least 50 % marks in the KAIET shall be considered eligible for provisional admission to the programme of the constituent college of the University.

Merit list of the candidates will be displayed on the University website www.kvv.edu.in.

As per the Order dated 28/08/2017 of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in SLP to appeal (C) No. (s) 30336/2016, W.P. No 267/2013, I.A. No 78432/2017 in W.P.(c) No.76/2017, Admissions to MBBS, Postgraduate/Super speciality programmes of Faculty of Medicine, BDS, Postgraduate Programmes of Faculty of Dentistry admission shall be as per the counselling schedule published by DGHS/MCC on their website.

ADMISSION OF STUDENTS:

1. A student 'Applying for Admission' to a college/Faculty shall produce a School Leaving Certificate or College leaving Certificate, as the case may be signed by the Dean/Principal of the of the constituent college or Head of the Institution last attended by him/her.
2. 'Applicant' means a person who has been admitted to an Examination by the University (KAIET).
3. 'Collegiate candidate' means an applicant who has applied for admission to the University Examination through the constituent College/Institution in which he/she has been prosecuting a regular course of studies.

4. 'Examinee' means person who actually present himself/herself for an examination or a part thereof to which e/she has been admitted.
5. All admissions are to be completed on or before the prescribed date as per academic calendar notified by the University from time to time.
6. A student who has studied last at an Institution/College affiliated to another University or Board shall produce a Migration Certificate from that University or Board, in addition to the Leaving Certificate from the Head of the Institution/College attended last. Such a student shall also pay an immigration fee as prescribed by the Competent Authority from time to time.


Provided that an Undergraduate student migrating to this University in the mid of the session may be permitted to join programmes in the University during the First Term of the session only, on the conditions laid down hereunder:

- I. That he produces a certificate from the College last attended by him that his attendance in that College has been adequate in accordance with the prescribed rules of the said College.
- II. That he attends 80 percent of the classes conducted in each subject of his study in the College after his admission to it.
- III. That he shall not be admitted in a College of the University in a higher class than that in which he was studying in the College affiliated to his former College / University.

Provided that the last qualifying examination passed by him/her is recognized by this University as equivalent to its corresponding examination.

7. The last date for admission to a College and /or Post – Graduate department in the University shall be as per the date notified by the respective Apical Council and the University from time to time.
8. A student shall be deemed to be enrolled as a student of a College as soon as he has been so accepted by the Dean subject to the final acceptance of his enrolment.
